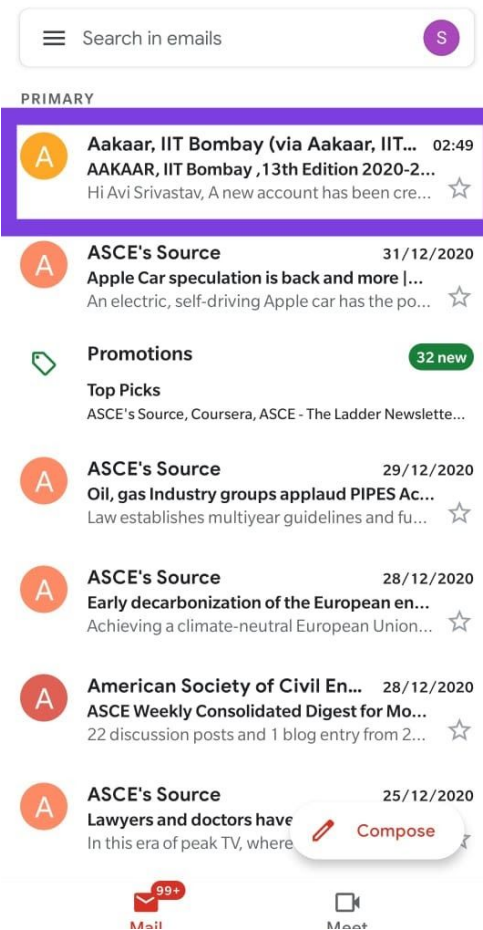




How to login on moodle AAKAAR

STEP 1

Check inbox of your registered mail id. You should have received a mail like this from AAKAAR IITB admin, giving login details for your moodle gnomio account. If not received , contact the corresponding managers, or email us at ask.aakaariitb@gmail.com

In most mail programs, this should appear as a blue link which you can just click on. If that doesn't work, then cut and paste the address into the address line at the top of your web browser window.

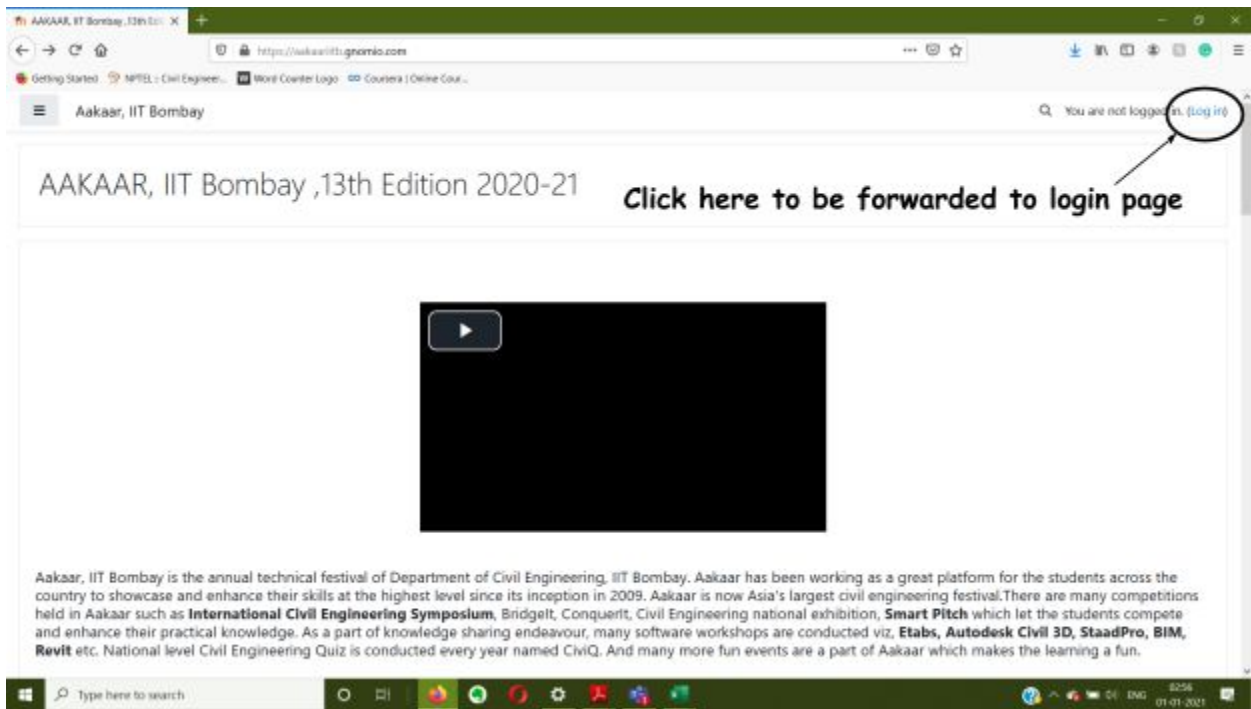

STEP 2

Visit <https://aakaariitb.gnomio.com/> on your internet browser. (works well on firefox and chrome) .Click on the login button/link on the top right corner of the site.





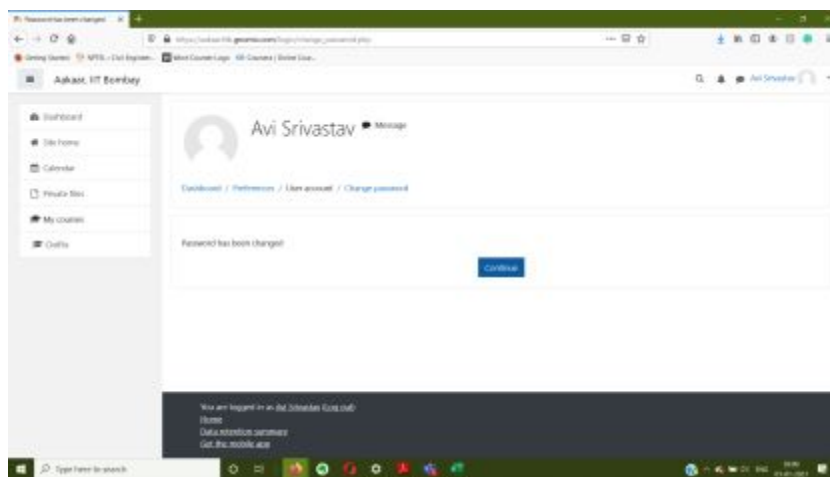
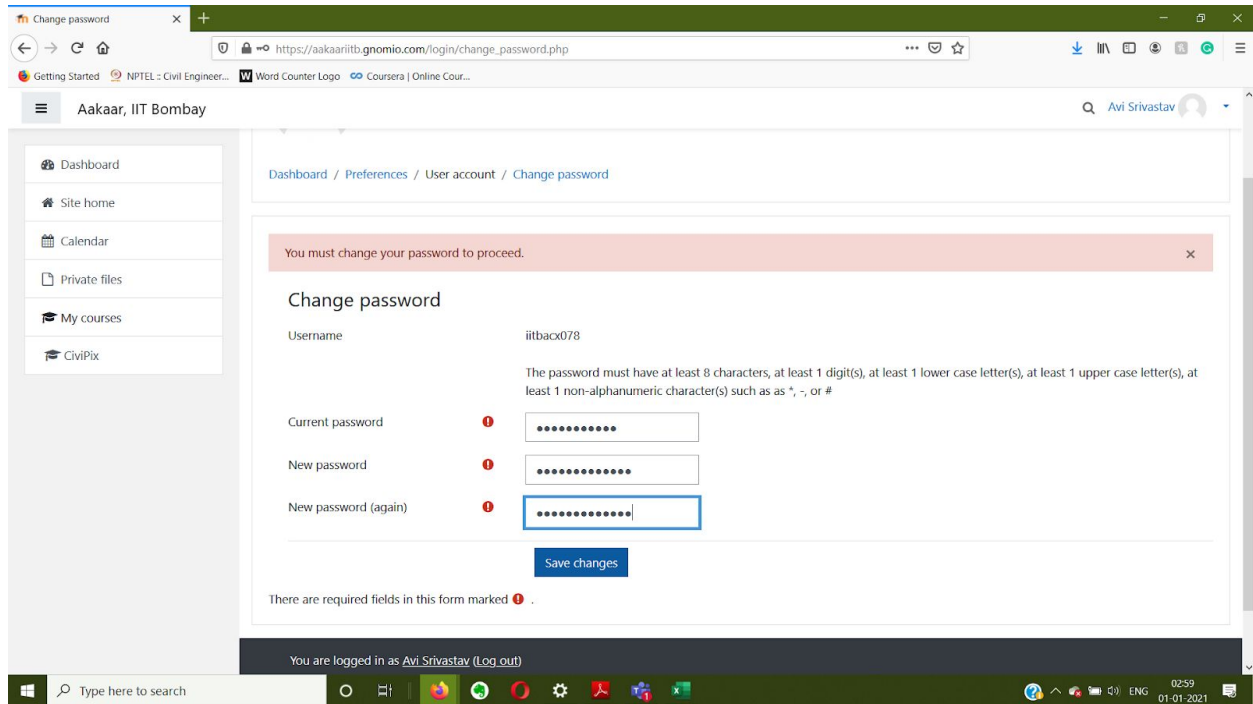
Enter your login details , i.e. username and password as sent on your registered mail id





STEP 3

After logging for the first time, you'll be forwarded to a change password page. Change your password (mandatory), to safeguard your account and complete registration process with moodle. Click on save changes.
